Thailand

Bangkok: Courses flooded in late 2011 are reopening. In particular, the new Royal Gems Golf City replica course commenced operations last month with conditions now being around 90% of what they were previously. Clubhouse constriction continues and permanent facilities are expected to be in place by the end of the summer. Let me know if you want to play "Bangkok's Augusta" on your next Bangkok trip.








With one clear exception: golf tourism to Asia.


