Indonesia

Bali: A definite birdie is awarded to the Indonesian government for teeing-up a new Visa-free policy. Free 30-day permits will now be given to visiting golf tourists. This is great news and welcome timing. It makes Bali that much more affordable as an international golf destination and cuts out the usual visa-on-arrival hassles. Moreover, July to September is the absolute best time of year for golf in Bali.



Hanoi: Scoring a perfect par and getting in on the Visa free act, from July 1 Vietnam Visa requirements are waived for golfers from Germany, France, United Kingdom, Italy, and Spain. These five new countries are added to the Visa waiver already in effect for golfers from Japan, Korea, Norway, Finland, Denmark, Sweden, Russia, Brunei, Indonesia, Malaysia, Thailand, Singapore, and the Philippines. This is perfect for our European friends and we look forward to seeing more golfers in Vietnam from all of these countries soon.

course next to the current Saigon airport is getting great reviews from the players, but not from the residents. Located next door to Vietnam's busiest airport, the locals question the use of the land for a golf course, while their surrounding neighborhoods are jammed and the airport is already overcrowded. Plans call for Vietnam's busiest airport to be moved to Long Thanh (coincidentally also near existing golf courses) to alleviate the congestion around Tan Son Nhat, but this may take another 5-10 years. In the meantime, golf is open for play and the Army-managed course is pretty good.



Golf Travel Testimonials - David Rendall - Golf in Thailand

My name is David Rendall. I recently travelled to Thailand with a golfing party of 12, the majority from Scotland & Ireland, however a couple of our group are based in Dubai and Thailand.

Most of the guys are members of the same golf club, Pumpherston, which is 10 miles from Edinburgh. Pumpherston is a lovely parkland course but also features a lot of water; it's a very modern design considering its age. I have been a member for the last 25 years and currently play off 12, however our group's handicaps range from 5 to 18.

Our group have holidayed in Thailand for the last 6

years, initially for a friend's 50th birthday celebration. We have golfed all over the world; America, the Caribbean, China, Ireland, Spain, Portugal and the Canaries. Finding that the cost of golf in mainland Europe had become very expensive prompted us to venture as far afield as Asia. We love the quality of the courses in Thailand with Hua Hin a favourite (Thailand's "Myrtle Beach"); in particular, Black Mountain, Banyan, Majestic Creek and Sea Pines are some of our favourites. We have booked with Golfasian for the last 5 years through a mutual friend and have never looked back. Golfasian's attention to detail is superb...they never let us down.

In Hua Hin, where possible we always stay in a small 3 star hotel right in the centre of town, La Maison, which has rooms that are a good size and a first class breakfast. The staff are always delighted to see us, perhaps because our group of 12 fills the bar each early evening while we exchange stories after our round, prior to heading out to dinner. We tend to play a Ryder Cup-style event every day teeing off around 10.30am.

We love all the courses but have a soft spot for Royal Hua Hin which is a great test of golf and is designed by a Scotsman. The caddies' knowledge of the greens is amazing; your eyes tell you it's three holes right but the caddy says half a grip left...an oft-repeated phrase follows "why you not listen" but always with a twinkle in their eyes. My favourite day was last November. I started with a triple bogey 7 on the 1st at Banyan, par at the 9th saw me out in 35 gross and 7 up. I didn't play that well on the back 9 but won the match 6&5 so happy days. The weather in November is perfect, just before we return home to the bleak Scottish winter.

After golf we normally have lunch at the course (losers paying the bill) and enjoy a few beers before Golfasian's Khun Noh (best driver in Hua Hin and a very good golfer) returns us to the hotel. Some of the guys go for a nap or do some shopping prior to us all meeting in the hotel bar at 7pm for a few drinks. Hua Hin has some wonderful restaurants from the Moon Smile (Thai) to some great Italians. The French restaurant next to La Maison, La Paillotte, is fabulous. We have even found a very good Indian restaurant so everyone is happy with the quality of the food.

All in all Thailand golf ranks amongst the best in the world as an experience as far as we are concerned. If you haven't tried it, I thoroughly recommend it and am confident you won't be disappointed.

Kanchanaburi - A Destination Review

Kanchanaburi and the River Kwai area is another destination to golf in Thailand. It has some of the loveliest and most challenging golf courses, rarely visited by golf travelers and hardly included in most Thailand golf holiday packages.

Kanchanaburi, sometimes referred to as River Kwai, is the third largest province in Thailand. The River Kwai is located 130 km west of Bangkok, and is easily reached in 2 hours by car. Kanchanaburi shares a border with Myanmar (Burma). The Kanchanaburi terrain is comprised mainly of mountains and high plains. Most of the local population is of Thai ancestry with some Mon and Karen hill tribe minorities that add an exotic touch to golf in Kanchanaburi.

Up to now golf in the River Kwai area has been something of a secret. However, those who have the chance to golf in River Kwai will discover truly spectacular golfing.

Featured Golf Course - Grand Prix Golf Club

(spectacular course is one of Thailand's best)

Grand Prix Golf Club is a well-conditioned golf course in Thailand's Kanachaburi Province that will take your breath away. The course is set in a vast open space with panoramic views of Burmese mountain ranges in the distance. A large river bisects the course and adds to the native scenery. It takes around 30 minutes to reach the site from Kanchanaburi town or 2 hours from Bangkok.

Grand Prix makes excellent use of significant mounding and undulations through the fairways and greens. Many holes have split fairways offering golfers both a more challenging and a straightforward approach to the greens. Multi-tiered greens have lots

of break so it pays to select the correct club for each approach shot; otherwise 3-putts or worse are likely.

Hua Hin, Thailand, 29 June 2015 -- The Centara World Masters Golf Championship has confirmed its status as Asia's biggest and richest tournament for club golfers and is now set to become even bigger next year.

More than 700 visitors from 23 countries, representing 181 golf clubs, converged on Thailand's resort town of Hua Hin for the second annual tournament, held from 14-19 June at four local courses.

Golfing Tips - When the going gets tough, be patient and go back to basics

Having just watched all the drama from the last day at the 2015 US Open Championship and witnessed the frustration of the best golfers in the world I am reminded that all of us experience similar demons and doubts in our own rounds. Luckily in Thailand we also have caddies who can put everything in context and relieve the tension. But if this round really matters to you, there must be a way to get back on track.

A good way to "reset" is to go back to basics focusing on fundamentals. Start with your grip and posture, squaring up shoulders, hips and feet to the target line. Get as comfortable as you can and visualise the flight that your intended shot will make. Commence



your takeaway as smoothly as possible and release from the top continuing through the ball into a completed swing, trusting the result rather than anxiously looking for it.

Concentrating on the basics will lead to better results if you believe in them. Once back on track, then you can do the same on the greens and make some birdies.
