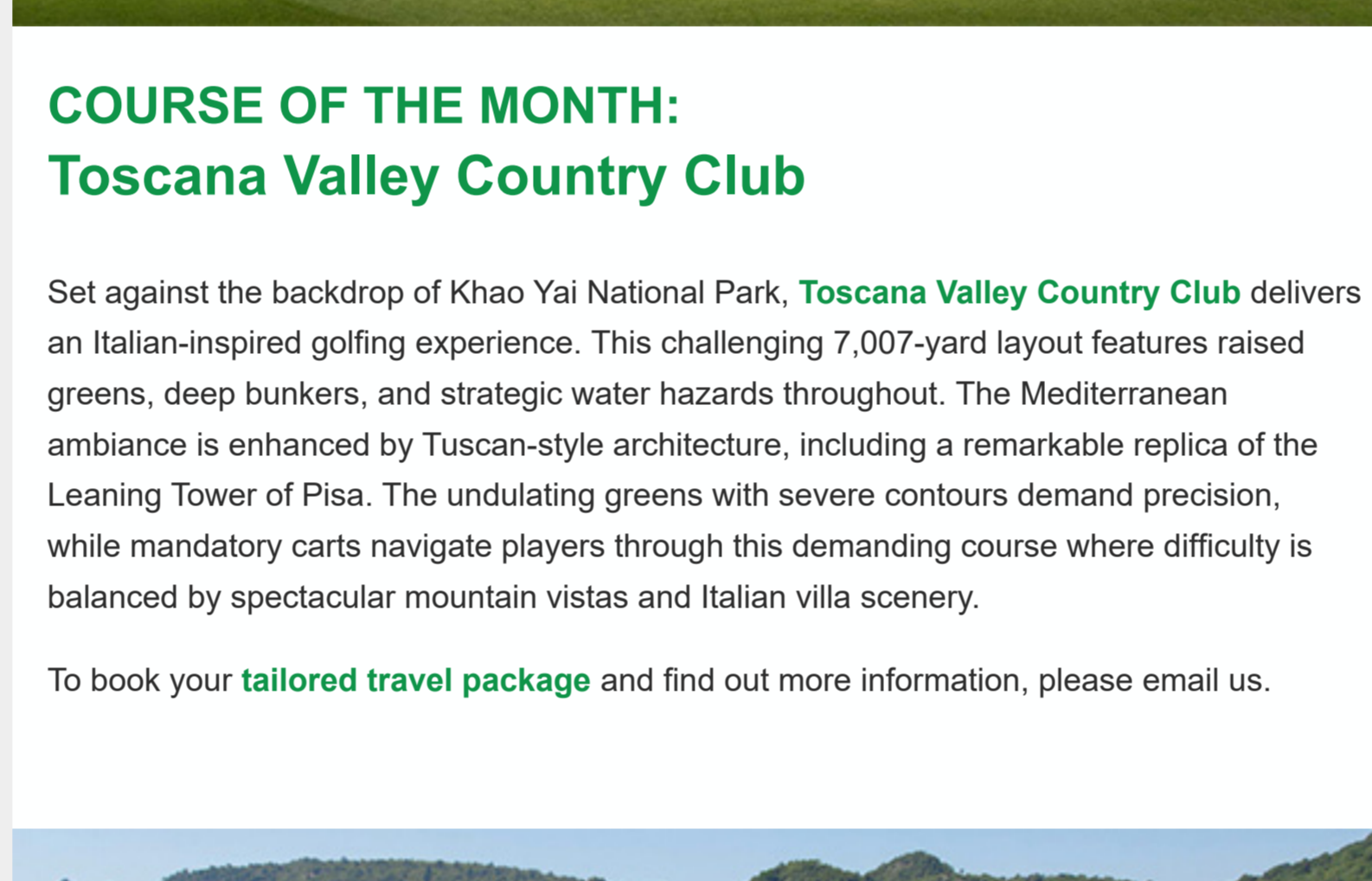


DESTINATION OF THE MONTH: Khao Yai

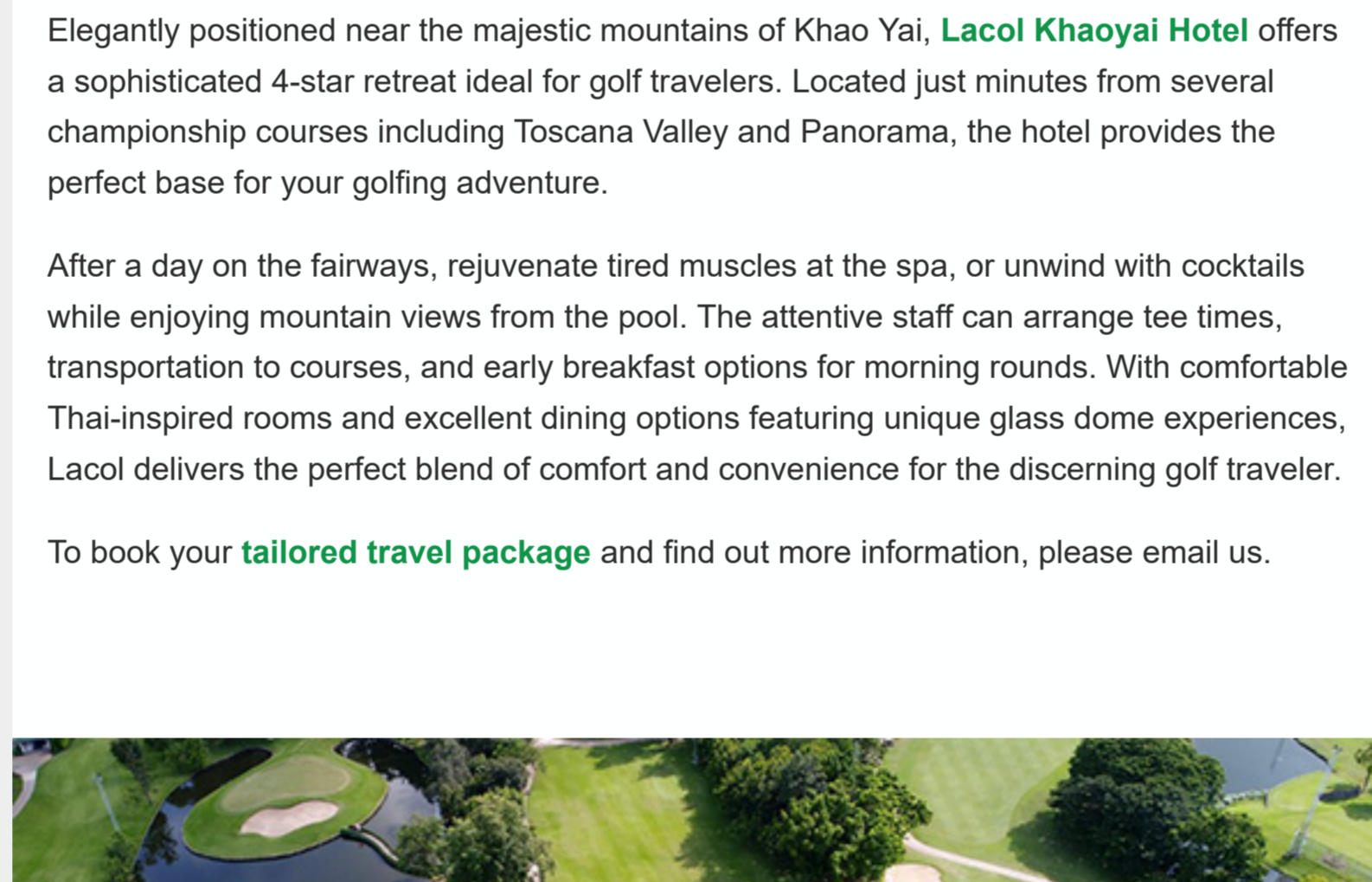

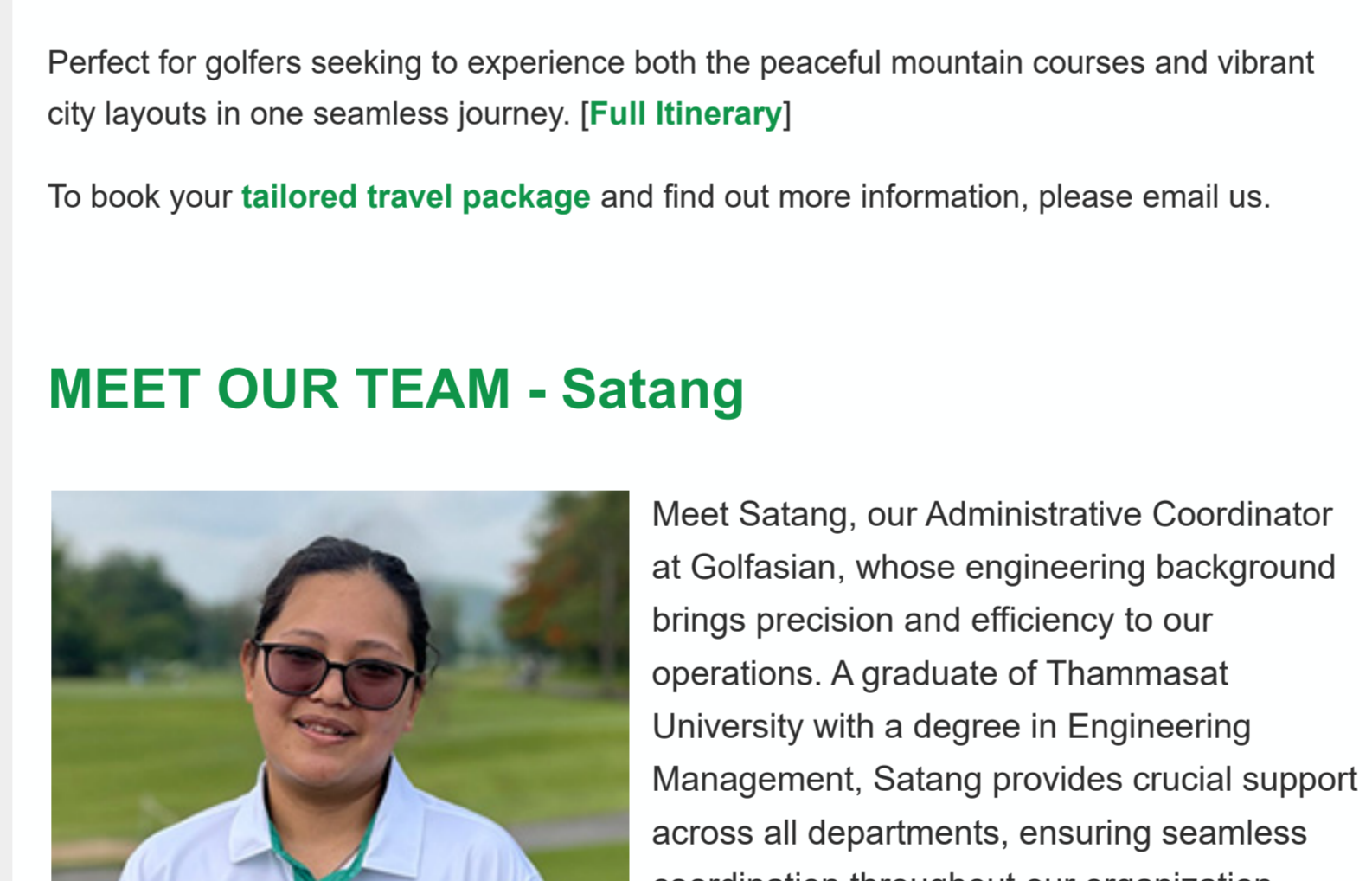

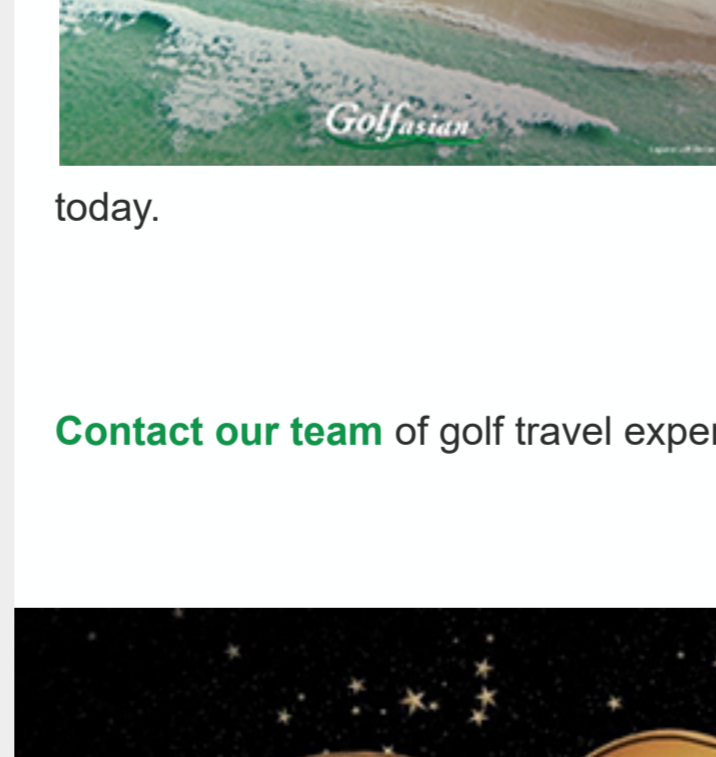

MEET OUR TEAM - Satang



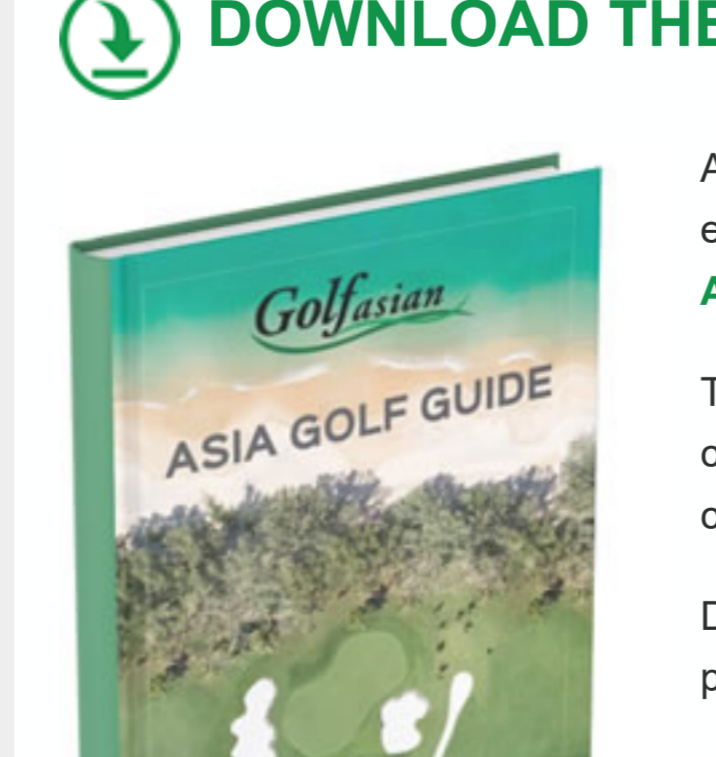

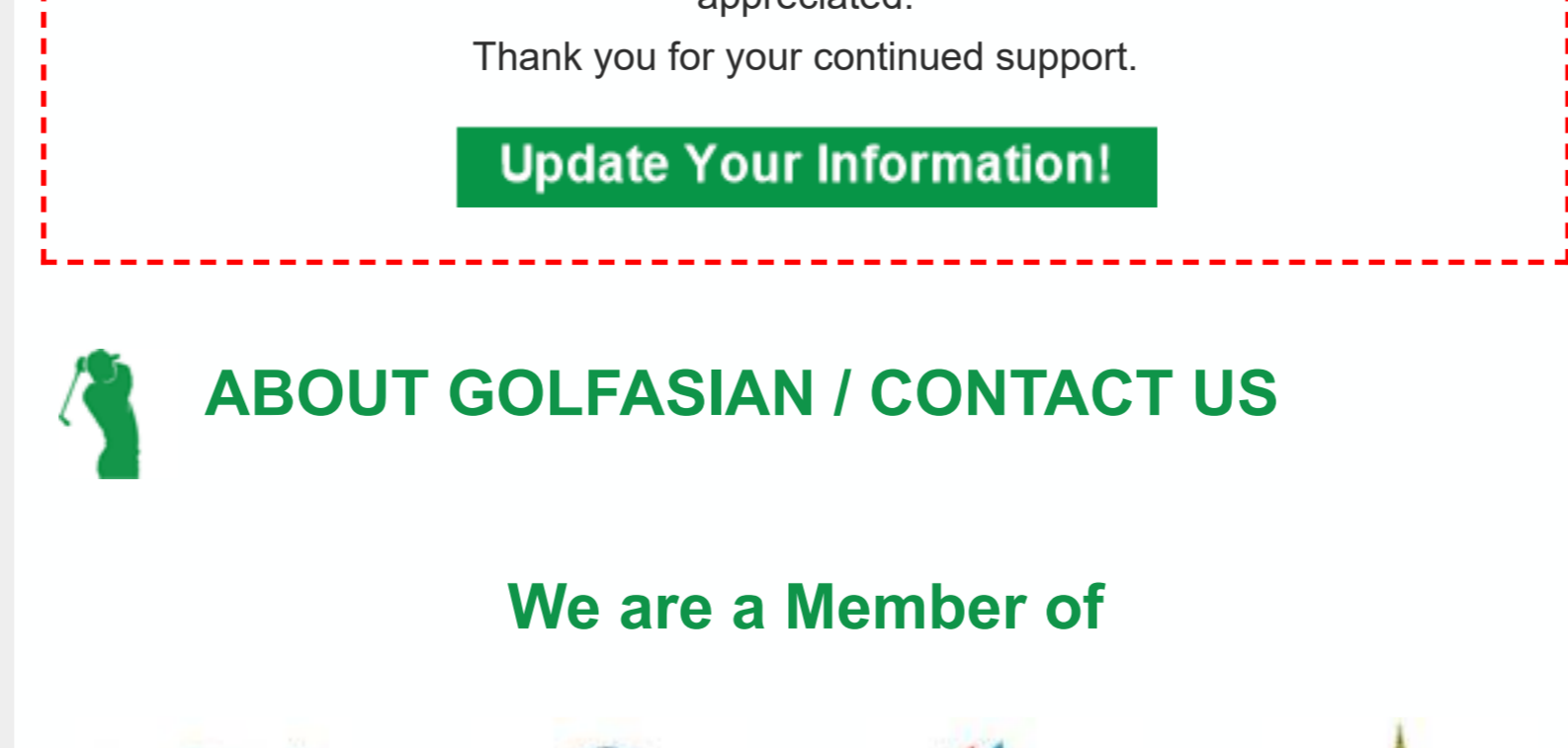
